
We received over 40 responses. The majority of survey participants indicated that they are ready for some kind of outdoor event.


Racing Update from Mariellen Stern

The Short-Handed races are next so, join us on Saturday, Sept. 26. Sign up on <u>Jibeset</u>.




Thank you to all who participated!

Tiburon Yacht Club Race 1 of Mott Midwinters

Between ISO and R-14

An incredibly challenging day that ended with a surprise!

The Bob and Esther Mott Midwinter Series began with noticeably light air out of the Northwest but as the boats raced it changed at each mark making it an incredibly challenging day that ended with some surprises! We had 12 competitors for this, the first race in the Mott series.

Before we dive into the race, we owe our gratitude to Cameron Tuttle and the crew of Joyride who again ran race committee from the water.

Cam got the race organized by taking check ins, announcing the course, and giving the warning time for the scratch boat Cinnamon Girl (double handing) and for the rest of the 11-boat remaining boats.

The race's first mark was ISO. Cinnamon Girl started and easily rounded it to starboard. She then headed toward the second mark, R-14. The wind was getting lighter which allowed Lion to overtake Cinnamon Girl and round R-14 first.

Lion was now leading the pack ahead of Cinnamon Girl with Ian Matthews (single handing) on Siento el Viento, immediately behind.

We were all heading toward the TYC mark.

Thank you to all participants!

As the breeze continued to diminish, the Bay was like glass with all the boats now drifting slowly down toward TYC.

Joyride soon overtook Cinnamon Girl as did Siento el Viento, Alice Shinn's Sonata, and the Ultimate 20's.

Lion was still in the lead as the wind shifted several times on the way to TYC. An approaching cloud bank on the other side of Trestle Glen brought yet another shift to the southwest and the breeze picked up. We were all so happy to see those clouds as they brought the wind that allowed all boats to finish.

First across the finish line was Joyride, who narrowly finished ahead of Lion by just one second! Followed by Alice Shinn's Sonata, Ian Matthew's Siento el Viento, the Ultimate 20's and Cinnamon Girl.

There was another tight finish between Commodore Chris Cooper's Sunrisa and Austin Dito's Dolcezza with Sunrisa finishing just 29 seconds ahead of Dolcezza. The official race results are HERE


